By mistake of the white man who was my informant and assistant I applied for Lots 2, 3, & 5 of Sec 6 Tp 24 N of R 6 East which I believed to be the land I desired, but which I have since been informed is incorrect, and that the true description of the land I desire, and which I now pray to be allowed to enter is Lot 1, 2, 3 & 5 of Sec 6 Tp 24 N. R. 6. E. because my improvements are almost entirely on said Lot 1, and the brook which runs through said Lot 1 is the great value and chief inducement for me to make that land my Homestead.
